

SUN CATCHER

You'll need

1. Paper plate
2. Scissors or X-acto knife
3. Transparent contact paper
4. Hole punch
5. Ribbon
6. Natural decorations like leaves, flower petals, pine needles – go on a nature walk to collect these, but be sure to disturb as little as possible!



Instructions

1. Have an adult use the scissors or X-acto knife to cut a circle out of the paper plate, leaving only the outside frame.
2. Cut 2 circles of contact paper, a little bigger than the empty circle in the plate.
3. Turn the plate upside-down and stick the first of the contact paper circles on the bottom, so the sticky side is exposed at the bottom of the plate.
4. Turn the plate right-side up and decorate it with the natural decorations.
5. When you're finished, cover the decorations with the second piece of contact paper.
6. Use the hole punch to make a hole in the top of the plate.
7. Thread the ribbon through and tie a knot so you can hang your sun catcher.
